# Highland Woods

MAKES A NATURAL TREASURE BETTER

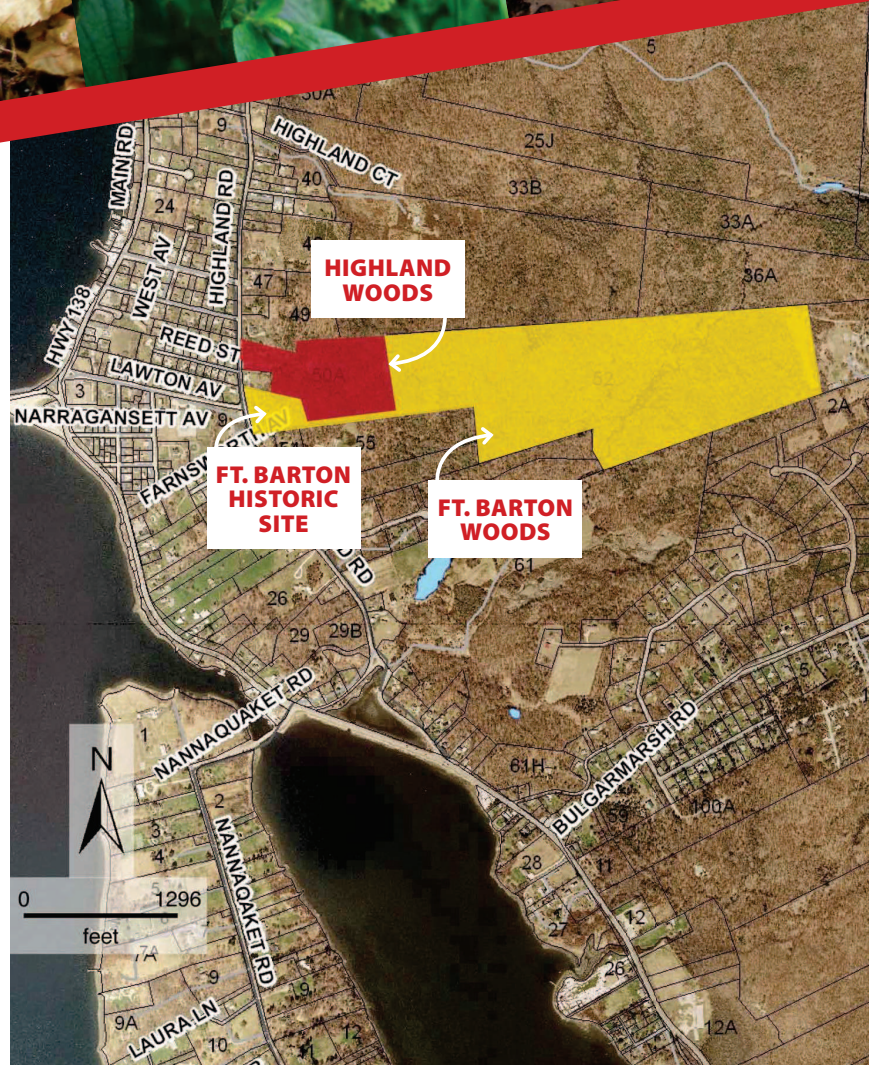


Tiverton Land Trust's recent acquisition of Highland Woods expands one of the Town's most signature natural treasures. The former Clark property will preserve 16 additional acres of hardwoods and valuable wetland.

Abutting Highland Woods is Tiverton's Fort Barton Woods with its pristine Sin and Flesh Brook winding through towering oaks and quiet fern glades. In springtime trout lilies droop in dappled sunlight and wood anemones dance in warm breezes, all within earshot of cool vernal pools alive with spring peepers.

Consider these comments in the RI Wild Plant Society journal, describing what can be seen in this woodland:

*Go there in August when brilliant red cardinal flowers grace the stream banks... Or go in October when the otherwise demure maple leaf viburnum proudly displays its rosy pink foliage in the understory. This is a fine place to leave the iPhone at home, find a shady bend in the brook, hang your feet in the water and listen to wood thrushes singing in the forest canopy.*
