- ✓ Arts & Craft vendors are not allowed to sponsor raffles, sell food or beverages, or solicit donations, except with the advanced approval of the Tiverton Land Trust and to benefit the Tiverton Land Trust.
- ✓ Booths must be managed by a responsible adult [or person over the age 16 at all times.
- ✓ No alcohol or firearms are permitted at Pardon Gray and no smoking of any kind is permitted.
- ✓ No vehicles will be allowed in exhibit areas between 9:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- ✓ Vendor setup must be completed by 9:30 a.m. and take down may not begin before 4:00 p.m.

✓ Neither the Tiverton Land Trust nor the Pardon Day Committee is responsible for any losses, costs, damages or claims by or against any vendor resulting from any theft, injury, property damage, inconvenience, act of God, or otherwise and any such claims are the sole responsibility of the Vendor. To the greatest extent permitted by law, the undersigned vendor and its agents and representatives (1) waive any claim that they may have against the Tiverton Land Trust and the Pardon Gray Day Committee, and (2) will indemnify and hold the Tiverton Land Trust, the Pardon Gray Day Committee and their members harmless for any losses, damages, or claims, including its reasonable attorneys' fees and litigation costs, brought against any of them by any person or entity arising out of or related to the vendor's participation in this event.

✓ Each vendor must take responsibility for their own State Tax-Exempt Certificate for this event. No vendor may give away their reserved space unless negotiated directly with PGD committee. All vendors must complete and return a contract/with fee to maintain their reservation. Payment for Pardon Gray Day is nonrefundable unless the event is cancelled.
